MEDLINE/PUBMED and *Lymphology* Archived

Lymphology's Medline/PubMed recertification has just been approved by the National Library of Medicine (NLM) for both print and online versions. As a Medline/PubMed Journal published before 1988, we were informed that we were required to apply for recertification by June 2017, which was a time-consuming, rigorous, and highly competitive process. In addition, scanning of articles published during

2016 had been delayed because of federal budget cuts to NLM, and these were finally processed in Spring 2018. Now that we are once again in control of the Medline-PubMed process for our print and online editions, all 2017 and 2018 have been uploaded with an expected gradual regain of our 2016 Impact Factor of 1.92. Moreover, all *Lymphology* articles back to Volume 1, 1968, have been scanned and are now publicly available on our website.
