s will be immediately apparent, this issue of the *Journal of Ancient Egyptian Interconnections* focuses entirely on reviews of recent works on various aspects of ancient Egypt's interconnections with the surrounding world. A large number of titles germane to this theme has been published over the last year, and this special issue combines reviews of a number of the works that have been received – as there are more than can be accommodated in a regular issue of the journal. Although widely different, the books reviewed are all important for the study of Egyptian interconnections, and the editors felt that it would be better to present these reviews quickly rather than spread them over numerous future issues.

Due to the great deal of interest generated by JAEI 2:3 – the special issue on maritime interconnections – the editors have decided to produce another specially focused issue on interconnections between Egypt and the Aegean region. This will be the theme of JAEI 3:2 which is planned for publication in early summer of this year.

JAEI 3:3 and 3:4, to be published respectively in early fall and winter of 2011, will then return to normal publication format with contributed articles on a variety of interconnection related topics.
