This atlas of lymphography bears witness to the vast experience of its author. The diagnostic criteria for a correct interpretation of lymphograms are presented in an excellent interpretation of lymphograms are presented in an excellent didactic form; important diagnostic signs are stressed and shown diagrammatically. The clarity and high quality of the figurative plates enable even the student to recognise in detail important pathological alterations in lymph nodes. The bibliography covers all the important contributions to this specialty during the last 10 years. Altogether, an excellent survey of the diagnostic principles of lymphography, and of particular value to every new student in this field.
