ISL Presidential Prizes

Two ISL Presidential Prizes will be awarded for young lymphologists to participate in the 28th International World Congress of Lymphology in Genoa, Italy, September 11-15, 2023. The nomination packet should contain:

- The nomination letter (1 page in length and addressed to the Secretary-General, ISL) from an active ISL member.
- Submitted abstract(s).
- Abbreviated curriculum vitae of the nominee (maximum 2 pages). The nominee should either still be in training or within 5 years of having completed training (PhD or medical residency or fellowship).

In addition, for the prize winners designated after peer review of the nomination packets, other assistance may be provided at the discretion of the 29th Organizing Committee. The ISL Presidential Prize winners will be honored during the Congress including at the Gala Banquet. All prize winners must attend the Congress and will be encouraged to submit a manuscript for peer-review publication in the journal *Lymphology*.

Call for ISL Officer Nominations

Nominations are now being received in the Central Office for ISL President-Elect (2-year term) and for 5 Executive Committee members for 4-year terms (maximum of 2 consecutive terms or 8 continuous years permitted), 2 members of the Nominating Committee, and 2 ISL-member Auditors.

Nomination packets should include the nomination letter from an Active Member of the ISL (self-nominations are allowed) and a full biographical sketch (curriculum vitae), along with specific information on service and/or contributions to the ISL or ISL-affiliate chapters/societies (e.g., serving as ISL officer, or on ISL committees/ taskforces, ISL and affiliate Congress organizer, Editor or reviewer of manuscripts for the journal *Lymphology*).

Nomination packets should be sent to the Central Office for review by the Nominating Committee. Nominations will also be accepted for consideration by the Nominating Committee if received by noon on September 11, 2023. Nominations will also be accepted from the floor at the General Assembly meeting.
